Expectations for Adults and Children at Retreat

Retreat planners ask you to follow these guidelines for participation of children and parents at retreat:

- 1. All children must be registered with an adult from their household. This applies to anyone under 18 years of age who is attending retreat. We strongly urge all parents and children to participate in planned activities on Saturday morning. This two-hour session is a vital part of fostering community and relationships with each other. Children especially may misunderstand peers' choices not to participate in planned activities.
- 2. If you must leave the retreat for any part of the weekend (except for off-camp excursions that are part of the retreat agenda), please take your children with you. Otherwise, children left at retreat unattended become a physical and legal liability of the whole group.

Suggested Payment:

- We ask households to pay as much as they can toward the cost of retreat, and the balance is funded by our annual church budget. Costs at Black Rock continue to rise each year, so this year we ask households with children and youth to contribute a nominal amount for each of them
- The following amounts are suggestions. If you are able to contribute more, it will help fund others' costs. If your household cannot pay the suggested amount, simply pay what you can and CMCL will cover the rest.
- When you register online, you will see there are options to register for part of the weekend as well.
- Suggested payment for full registration:
 - \$185/adult (80% of true cost)
 - \$50/youth age 13-18 (25% of true cost)
 - \$25/child age 5-12 (25% of true cost)
 - Children under age 5: FREE

Directions:

- 1345 Kirkwood Pike, Quarryville, PA
- From Lancaster, take Prince Street south. Follow Route 222 to Quarryville. Turn left at first light in Quarryville.
- Follow main street through Quarryville (about 1 mile) to Route 472.
- Turn right onto Route 472.
- Follow Route 472 for four miles.
- · Cross bridge.
- Entrance to Black Rock Retreat is on left. Follow signs to Maranatha Retreat Center.

Lodging:

All rooms are in the Maranatha Retreat Center and include one queen size bed, two single beds and a private bath. All are air conditioned with in-room thermostats. Linens and towels provided. Iron, ironing boards, and laundry facilities available for guest use. Wireless Internet in lobby and meeting rooms.

Amenities:

CMCLers have access to a gym, game room, large, comfortable lobby area, outdoor deck, hiking trails, playground, gaga court and nature center. All meals are provided by Black Rock's dining service and are buffet style with vegetarian options.
